We have to remember that we are not a political party. The use of social media must be handled with utmost care; reality shows that the keys to our mobile phones are often too easy to use.

We can meet this new challenge with dignity and pride; we have a rather long voting period, where canvassing is allowed. So, be a friend, also at elections".
